 - B. He is glad when you want to be with Him.



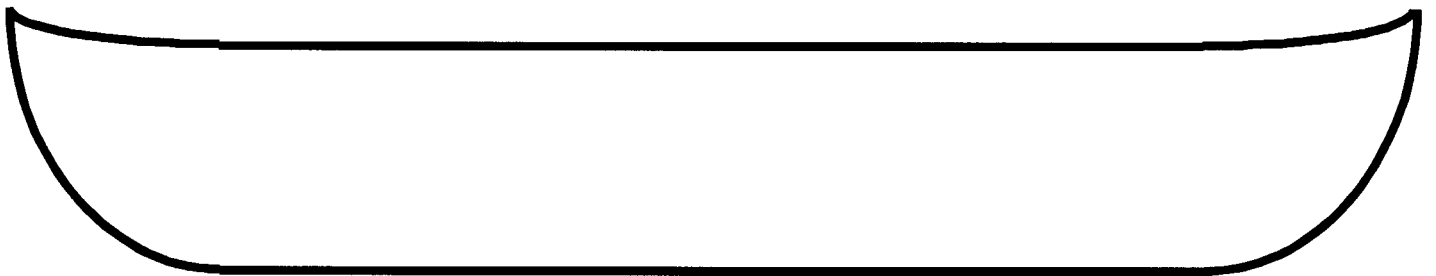
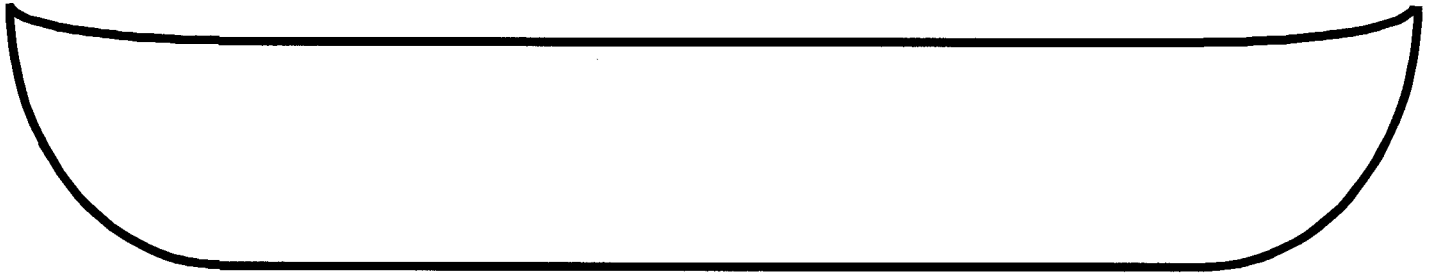
Enoch walked with God

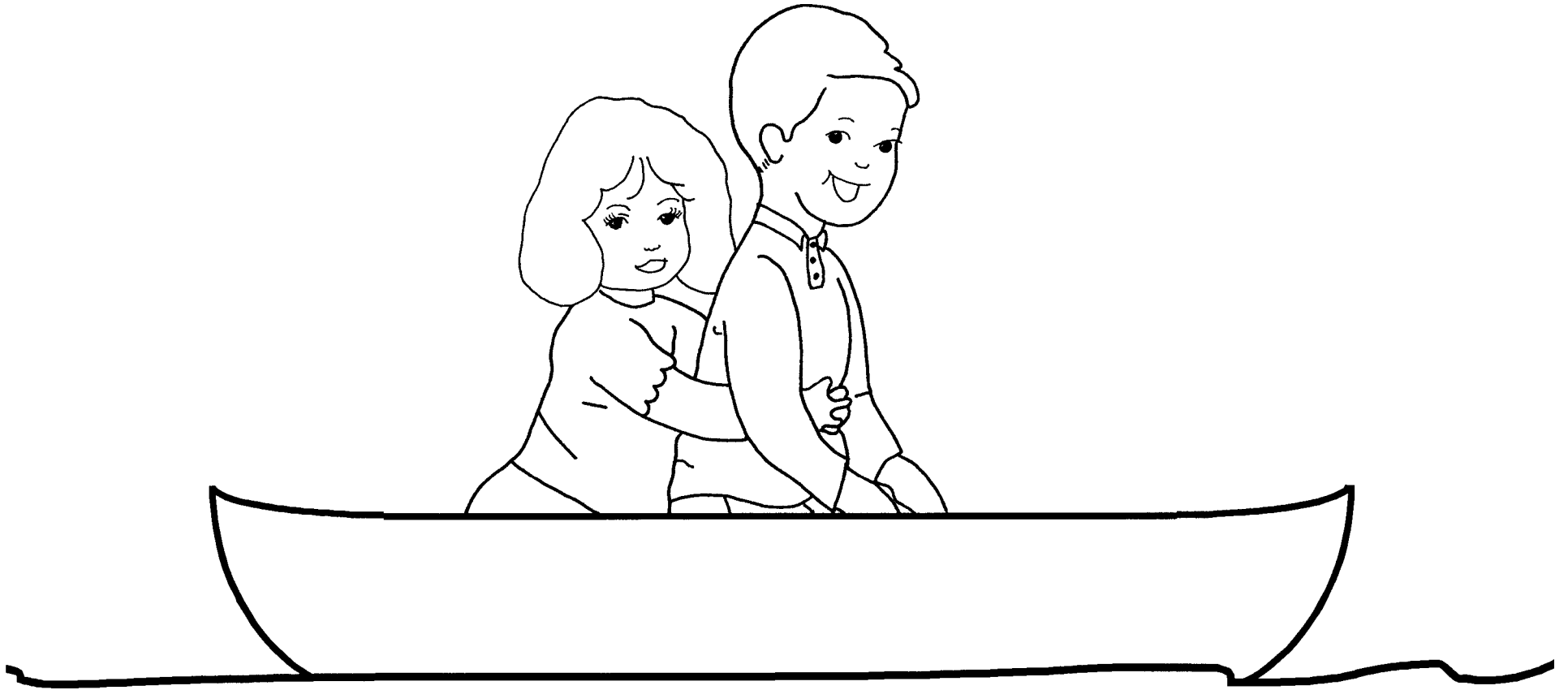
Bill and Jenny

Who would like to help me tell this story? *Choose a child to walk with you. Hold the child's hand as you walk.*

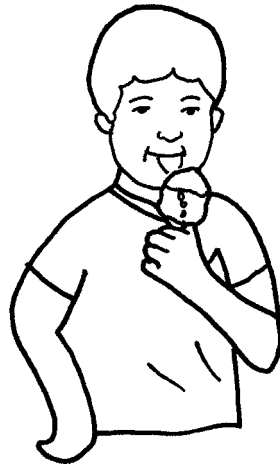
Child's name and I are friends. We like to be together. Right now we are walking together. We are talking about important things. Sometimes we laugh.

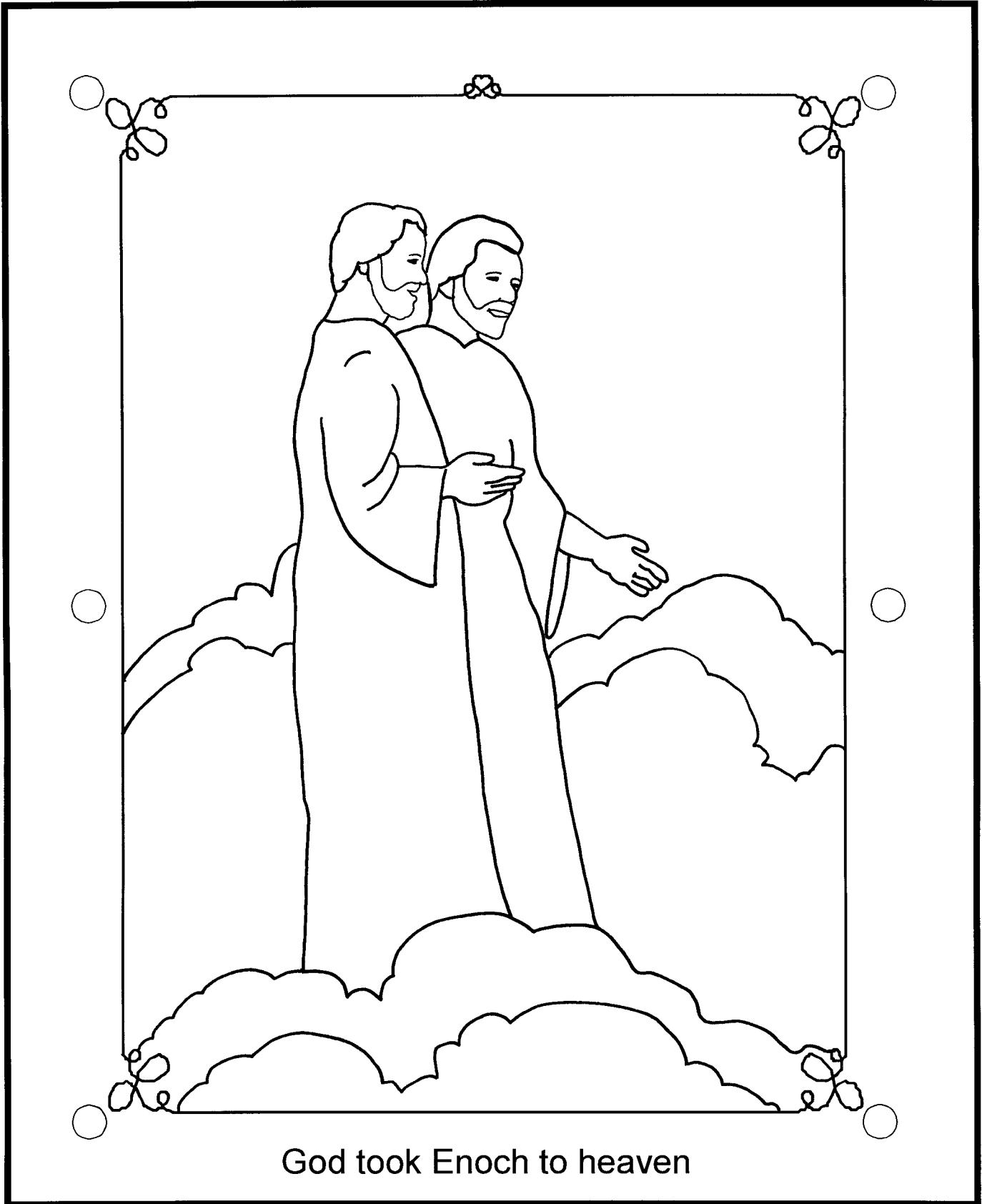
Enoch Walked With God
