1. Daniel was a very wise man who ruled under king Darius.

Display Indoor Scene (used as palace scene), Throne Room Overlay, King Darius Sitting, Daniel, Men.

- Daniel prayed daily to God.
- B. Everyone knew Daniel served God.

2. Other rulers wanted to get rid of Daniel.

- A. They tricked king Darius into making a bad law. If Daniel prayed to God, he would be thrown into the lions' den.
- B. Daniel continued to pray and give thanks to God.

den. Display Prison Scene (used with Cave Overlay), Cave Overlay, Door (over cave opening), Angel, Lions - Move and Add Daniel.

- C. The lions did not hurt Daniel.
- D. When king Darius found out that Daniel was safe, he was very glad. Add King Darius Standing.

4. You can trust God to protect you.



Daniel in the Lions' Den

Preparation:


Bring to class a white bed sheet. You will pretend to be an angel. Use the sheet as a robe. Have an adult helper pretend to be a lion. This person should be prepared to get down on the floor on their hands and knees.

What to Tell Them:

I am going to pretend to be an angel. Helper's name is going to pretend to be a lion. Who would like to pretend to be Daniel so that I can protect you from the lion? Choose a child and stand in front of them.

I am going to stand in front of Daniel so the lion cannot hurt him. The lion should begin to growl and crawl toward the angel. Lion, you cannot come near Daniel. Put your hands down and keep the lion from going past you. Have the lion keep trying to get Daniel for a short while, then say the following.

Boys and girls, an angel kept Daniel from getting hurt by the lion. God's angels will keep you from getting hurt also. Copy this page onto white or colored paper. Cut out wheel on solid line. Have children color each picture, or place stickers around the wheel, or glue the wheel onto colored paper. It is your choice!
