The Witnesses

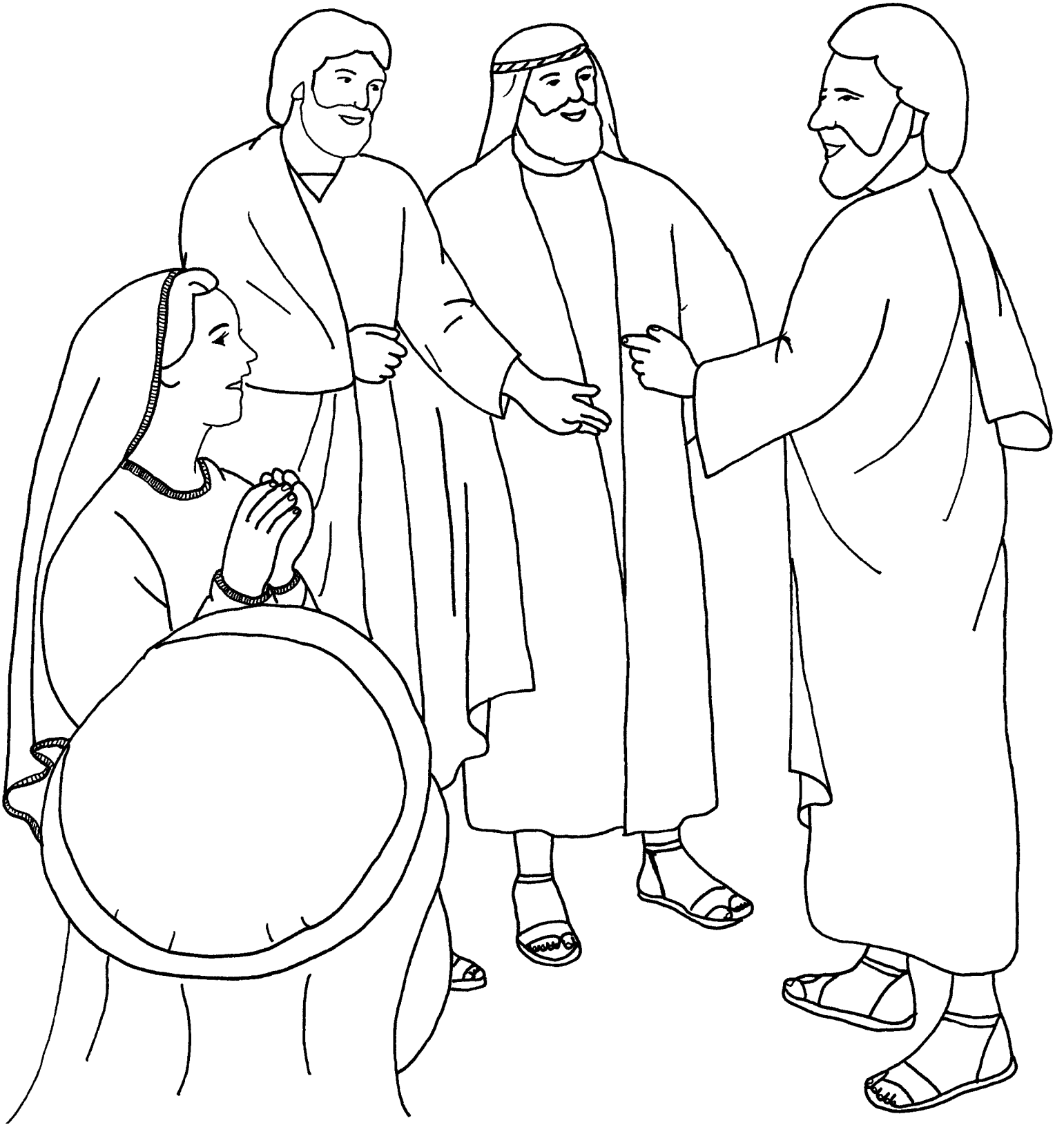
Luke 24:47-49, Matthew 28:18-20, Mark 16:15-16, Acts 10:38-43

- 1. Jesus told His disciples, “Tell everyone the good news about Me.”** *Display Water and Sky Scene, Hillside Overlay, Hillside Extension, Jesus, James Facing Right, Peter, John, Men, Women, Children.*
 - A. Jesus taught people about His Father God and healed all the sick people who came to Him.
 - B. The disciples saw Jesus die, put into a grave, and then saw Him after He came back to life.
 - C. Jesus said, “The Holy Spirit will help you tell everyone about Me.”

- 2. The disciples told people in every city about Jesus.**
 - A. They told everyone that God brought Jesus back to life.
 - B. They said, “Believe in the Lord Jesus Christ, and you shall be saved.”
 - C. The disciples taught everyone the same way Jesus did.

- 3. You can tell others about Jesus.**
 - A. Tell them Jesus is alive and that He loves them.
 - B. Jesus will save them.

“No.”

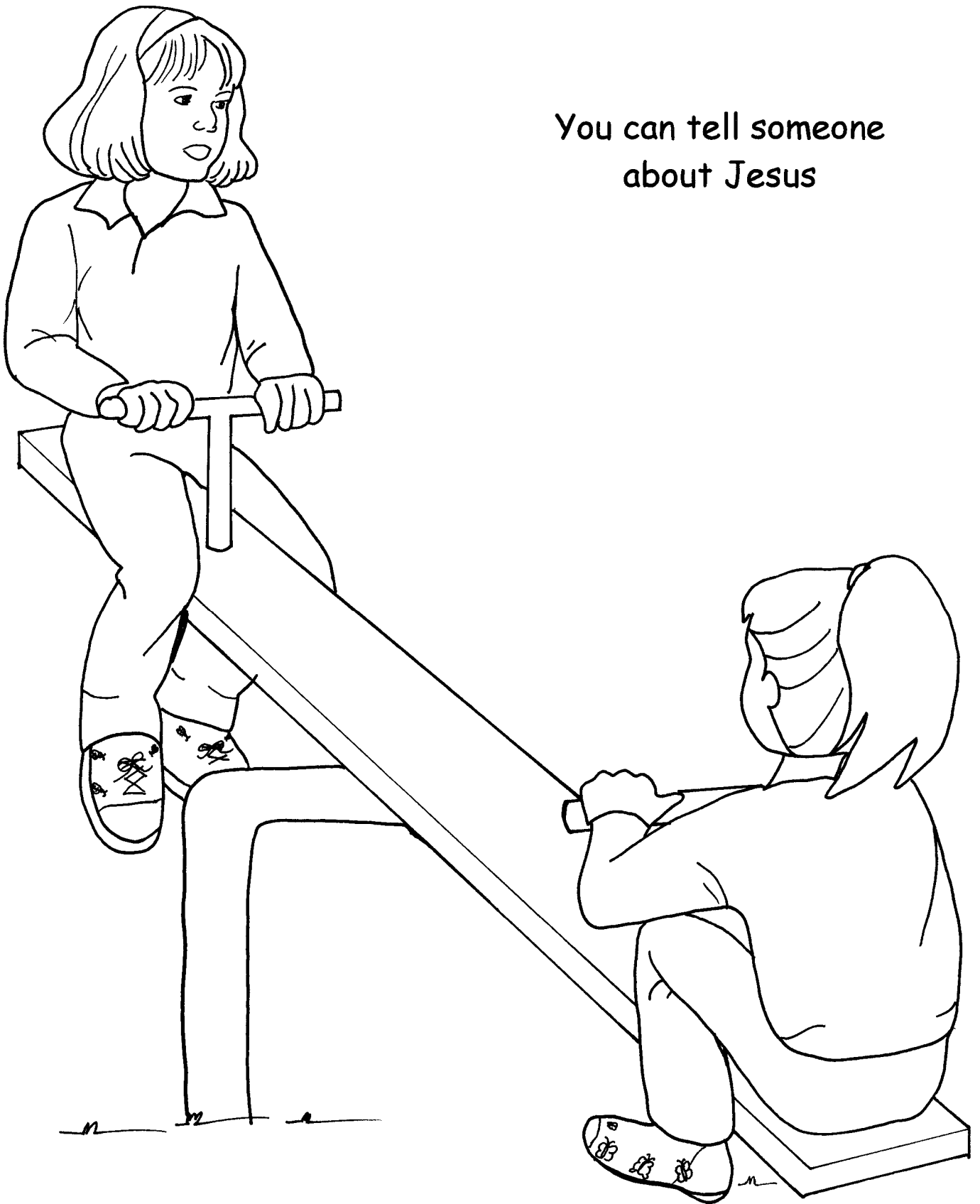
“He does. Jesus is our best friend. He died for us and then He came back to life.”

Bring to class a bouquet of flowers. The flowers may be real or artificial.

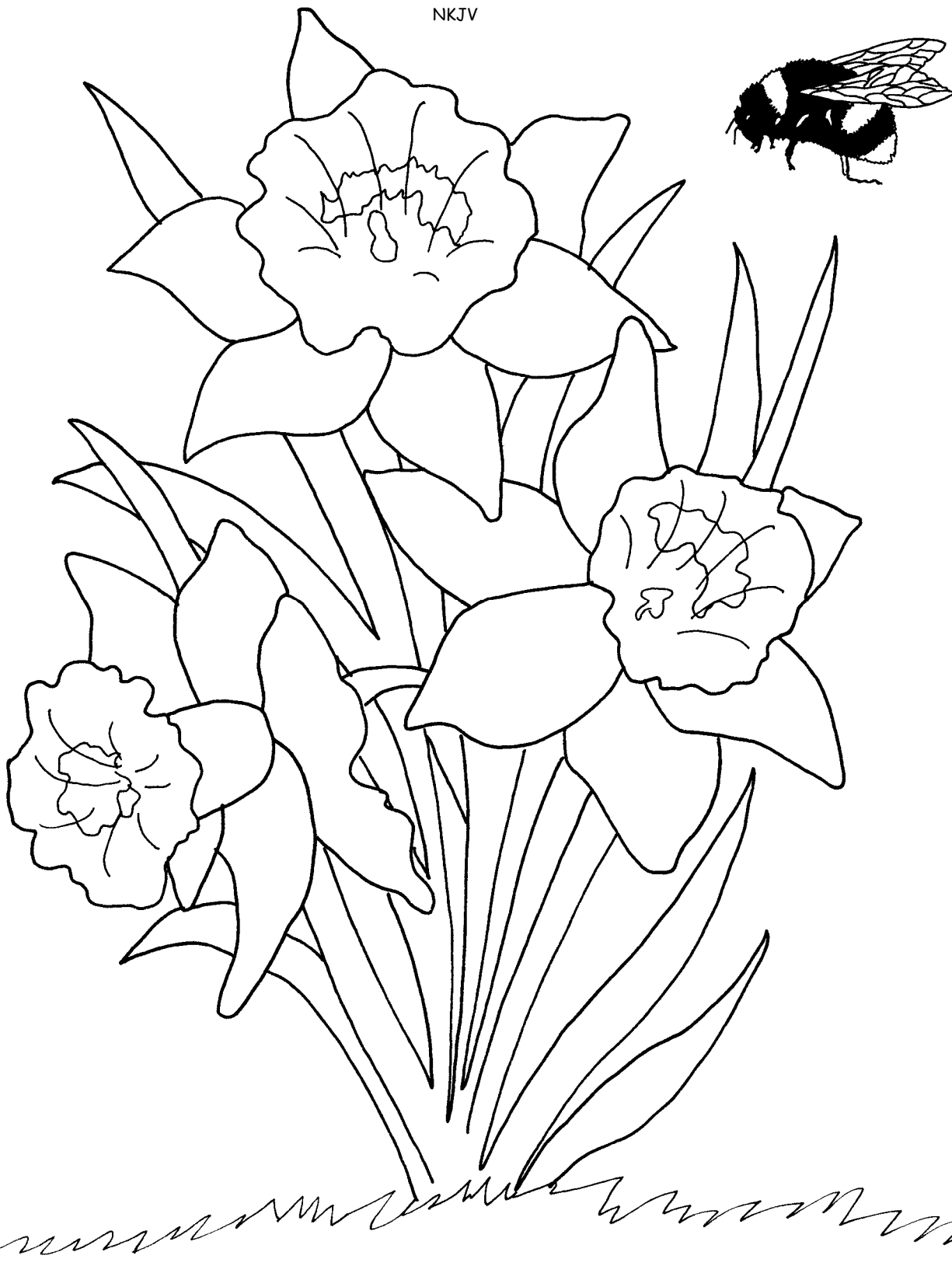
What to Tell Them:

Have you ever seen a bee buzzing around a flower? *Hold the bouquet of flowers in front of the children.* Bees get their food from flowers. When a bee finds flowers, she goes home right away. She tells all the other bees the good news about the food.

Tell the Good News

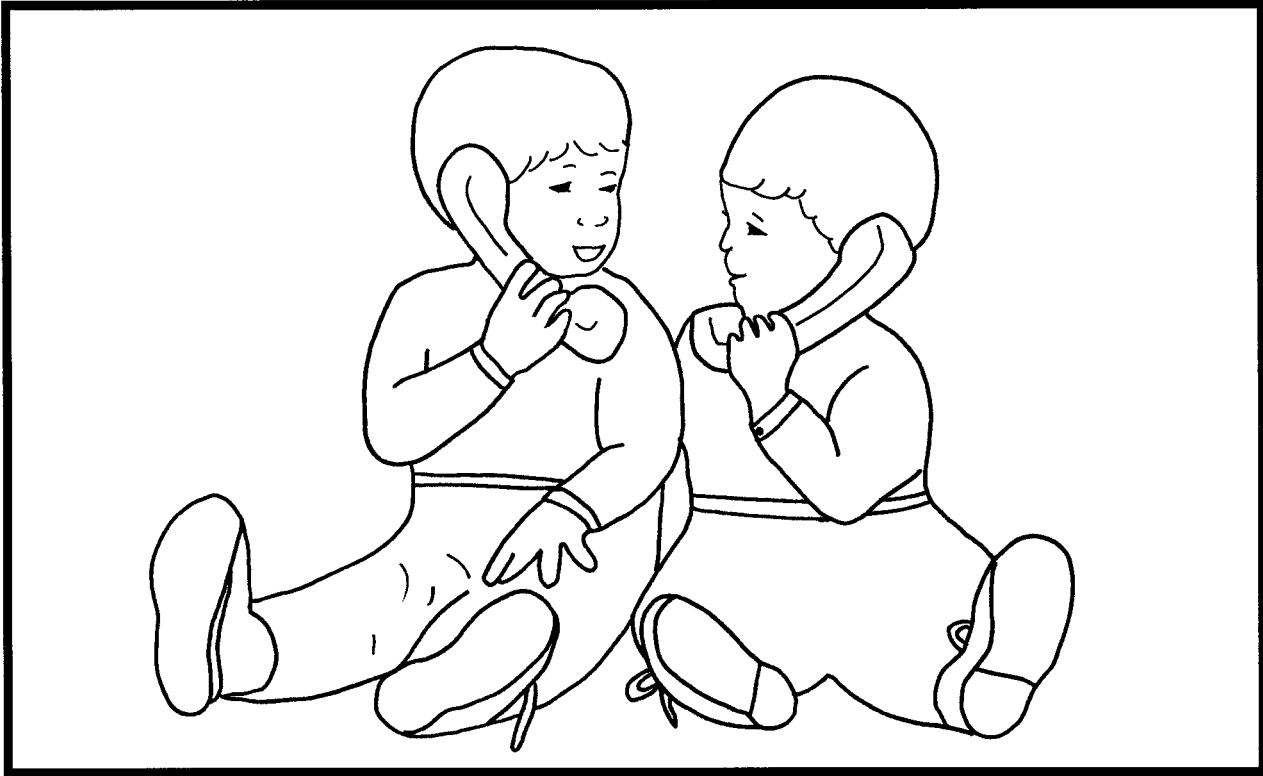
Can you tell me . . . who died and came back to life?

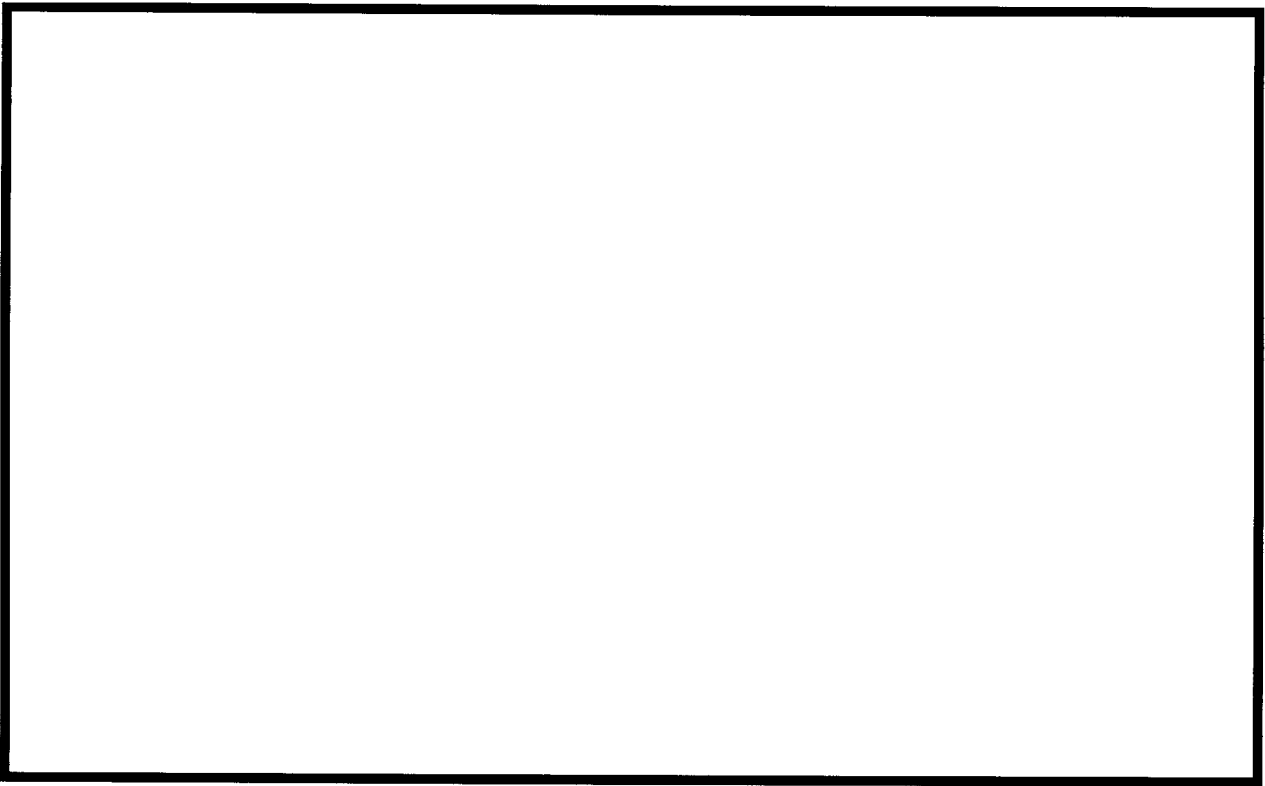
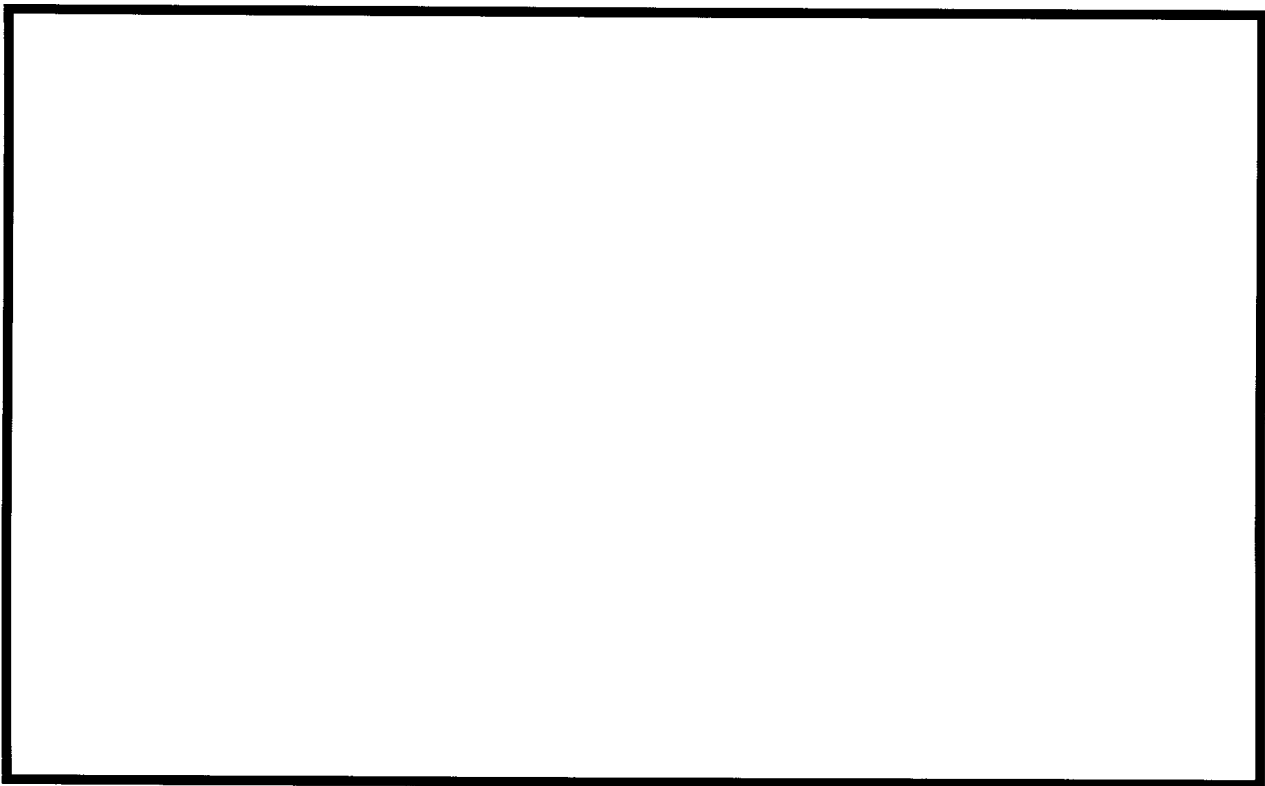
Pause briefly. Jesus did.
