Exodus 12:1-14, 26-36, Isaiah 53:4-7, 1 Peter 1:18-19 City Street Scene, Father (28), Father (32), Father (52), Children (108), Lamb's Blood (make per the page titled "Instructions for Lamb's Blood")

- 1. God saved the Israelites by the blood of a lamb. Display City Street Scene, Fathers, Children, Lamb's Blood (around doors).
 - A. God told the Israelites to kill a lamb and put the blood around their door.
 - B. That night, they stayed in the house and ate the lamb.
 - C. All of the firstborn children and animals were saved when death passed over their house.
 - D. God wanted the Israelites to know that some day He would send His Lamb, Jesus, to save all people.

2. Jesus came to be the Lamb of God.


- A. Jesus let Himself be put to death for us, then God brought Jesus back to life.

Instructions for Lamb's Blood

These instructions are needed only if you are using felt visuals to tell the story.

At first, we hesitated to show our children a visual picture of lamb's blood. But the Holy Spirit seemed to remind us of the text in Exodus 12:26-27. The children participated in the first Passover and watched as the blood was put around the door. Our children need to understand about the blood of Jesus.

A felt representation of the lamb's blood is simple to make. Cut nine irregular shapes from red felt as shown below. For the story, place the shapes around the doors on the City Street Scene.

"Mommy, did you know that the Israelites put lamb's blood around their door?"


"Yes. The lamb's blood saved their lives. When death passed over their house, every child and animal was kept safe. The lamb showed them that, someday, Jesus would save all people."
