## King Josiah

2 Kings 22:1 - 23:25, 2 Chronicles 34:1-3, Psalm 103:1-5 Indoor Scene (used as temple scene), Throne Room Overlay (pillars only), Priest with Scroll (23), Josiah as a Man (58), Workmen (87), Men (89), Women (97A), Women (97B), Children (108), Josiah as a Boy (115), Scroll for Josiah's Hand (315), Crown (16M)

  - A. Josiah loved the Lord because he knew the Lord is good.
  - B. Even as a boy, king Josiah did what was right in the sight of the Lord.
- 2. When Josiah got older, he wanted to fix the house of the Lord because it was broken down. Remove Josiah as a Boy, Crown

- Add Priest with Scroll, Josiah as a Man, Workmen.

- A. Josiah hired men to fix the house of the Lord.
- B. Hilkiah the priest found the Book of the Law in the house of the Lord.
- C. The Book of the Law was read to king Josiah.
- D. King Josiah was sorry because he knew that no one obeyed the Book of the Law.
- 3. King Josiah gathered all the people together and he read the Book of the Law to them. Add Scroll for Josiah's Hand, Men, Women, Children.


Little Blessings Bible Lessons

Josiah loved the Lord with all of his heart, soul and mind. Do you know why? Because Josiah knew that the Lord is good.



Characters:	Teacher Nutmeg (or your favorite puppet)
