

The Wind Obeys Jesus

Water and Sky Scene, Jesus Standing (7), Men in Boat (83), Clouds (171),
Cloud (172), Waves (182)

- 1. Jesus has been teaching people all day. He tells His disciples, "Let us go to the other side of the lake." Display Water and Sky Scene, Men in Boat.
 - A. Jesus' disciples are busy sailing the boat.
 - B. Jesus is so tired. He goes to sleep.
- 2. Now a windstorm has come onto the lake. Add Waves, Clouds.
 - A. Oh no! The waves are so high that they are filling the boat with water.
 - B. The disciples are afraid.
 - C. They wake Jesus up saying, "Master! Master! We are in danger!"
- 3. Jesus gets up and He speaks to the wind and the waves.

 Add Jesus Standing (to Men in Boat).
 - A. Jesus says, "Peace be still."
 - B. The wind and the waves obey Jesus. The lake is calm. *Remove Waves, Clouds.*
 - C. The disciples are amazed to see the power of Jesus' word at work.
- 4. Jesus brings the peace of God to you.
 - A. Jesus is the Prince of Peace and He lives in you.
 - B. Do not be afraid of bad storms or scary things.


Lisa and Grandfather




Can you tell me . . . what did Jesus say to the wind and waves? Pause briefly. Jesus said, "Peace be still."

Preparation:


Bring to class a raincoat, an umbrella and boots that fit you.

What to Tell Them:

Have you ever been outside when the wind started to blow and dark clouds start filling the sky? What do you do?

You can go inside and get a raincoat on. Put on raincoat. You can put on boots to keep your toes dry. Put on boots. You might get an umbrella so that you will stay dry. Show umbrella.

The raincoat, boots and umbrella can keep you from getting wet. But I have something better than this raincoat, boots and umbrella. I have Jesus living in me. He is the one who told the wind to stop blowing. Because Jesus lives in my heart, I always have His peace, no matter what the weather. Jesus brings the peace of God to you also.
