
- 1. Peter and John are going to the temple. Display Indoor Scene (used as temple scene), Throne Room Overlay (pillars only), Lame Man, Peter, John, Men.
 - A. There is a lame man sitting by the temple gate. He cannot walk.
 - B. The lame man asks Peter and John for money.

2. Peter and John have confidence in the name of Jesus.

- A. Peter and John are very sure that the man will be healed.
- B. Peter tells him, "Silver and gold I do not have, but what I do have I give to you: In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, rise up and walk."
- C. Peter takes the man by the right hand and pulls him up. Remove Lame Man Add Man Running.
- D. Now the man is walking and leaping in the temple, praising God.

3. You can have confidence in the name of Jesus.

When you ask in the name of Jesus, God will answer your prayer.

Pastor Miller said, "Are you sure, Kioko?"


Kioko stood up straight. "Yes, Pastor, I am very sure. Mrs. Miller said that he may have it."
